## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Pre-entries will be accepted until 9AM the day before the show.
2. Post entries will be accepted an additional \$20 Fee.
3. An Open Check must be presented in order to pick up numbers.
4. Stall Reservations guarantee payment. Stall Fees are non-refundable.
5. A \$20.00 fee will be charged to all entries for the cost of the EMT.
6. There will be no refunds or scratches after the start of the show.
7. \$50.00 fee will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
8. All entries not paid at the horse show will incur a \$50.00 late payment fee.
9. Prize money is credited against entry fees. Amounts won in excess will be paid by check within 30 days.
10. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant. Management retains the right to cancel any division with fewer than the minimum required by USEF rules. *If there are only 3 entries in a division, or Pony Hunter Classic, there will be a surcharge of \$40 if exhibitors wish to compete in a division/classic of 3.*
11. The Ridge Farm, LLC or the committee, will not be held liable or responsible for any accident, loss or damage, financial or otherwise, which may occur to any rider, spectator, groom, vendor, participant, horse, or equipment before, during or after the show.
12. All riders must wear proper attire and protective head gear at all times while mounted.
13. Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits. Back numbers must be issued and worn.
14. Hunter courses may be judged on performance, soundness, and manners.
15. Hunter courses may include gates, coops, walls, brushes, oxers, panels and combinations.
16. Every class offered is run in accordance with the specs of the current USEF Rule book.
17. A jump order will be established at the in gate with the starter.
18. Ties other than first, will remain tied.
19. Sharps containers will be located in the secretary stand.
20. Every animal in the show is under the control of The Ridge Farm show committee and/or the owner of management of same will be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
21. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
22. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
23. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allow them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), an/or

trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in the accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule.

24. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving competitions at the Advanced Level. Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Training Competitions upon payment of \$30.00 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the )Requirements of the this rule: 1) Lead line 2) exhibitions 3) games and races 4) Classes for –H members 5) Walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program) 6) USDF introductory level test, pas de deux and quadrille classes 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions of 8) Opportunity classes 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of own National Federation 10) USEA beginner novice division, And 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. ## **DIRECTIONS**

### **FROM FLORIDA TURNPIKE:**

Take the exit for Lake Worth Road West. Continue approximately 6 miles to South Shore Blvd. Continue to the stop sign at 50<sup>th</sup> Street. Make a right onto 50<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue to Stable Way and make a right. Continue to the end of Stables Way and make a left on Palm Beach Point Blvd. to the parking entrance on the right.

### **FROM ROUTE 95:**

Take the exit for the Forest Hill Blvd West. Continue to South Shore Blvd. Make a Left onto South Shore . Continue straight at light at Pierson road and again straight through the intersection at Lake Worth road, to the stop sign at 50<sup>th</sup> Street. Make a Right onto 50<sup>th</sup> Street, Continue to Stable Way and make a right. Continue to the end of Stables Way and make a left on Palm Beach Point Blvd. to the parking entrance on the right.

**Amateur Owner Hunter Division-      Entry Fee- \$225**

To be ridden by Amateur Owners or an amateur member of the owner's family. In either case classes are restricted to riders who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Lease horses are not eligible and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all owners are members of the same family.

An amateur who rides for a person outside of his/her family may not ride in a class restricted to Amateur Owners at the same competition. Amateur Owner riders may, however, ride for a person outside his or her family in equitation classes. Under Saddle classes and for other Amateur Owners who have more than one entry in the Under Saddle class. If an Under Saddle class is divided by age and a rider has two or more horses entered, all riders must be amateurs but need not be eligible by age. (HU105)

In classes over fences in Sections A & B, horse to jump 3'6". In classes over fences in Section C, horses to jump 3'3". All classes to be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

## **JUNIOR HUNTER DIVISION**

Open to riders who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Horses competing in this section may cross –enter into another section if otherwise eligible and need not to be ridden by a junior Exhibitor in another section. Nor horse may compete in this section unless the owner possesses a current Federation Measurement Card or Certified Card or copy of a valid measurement form issued by USEF. Equine Canada measurement cards are not acceptable (HU-168). Entries must be handled by a Junior Exhibitor in all phases of a Junior Class. Junior Exhibitors may not compete more than two (2) horses in each section.

In the Under Saddle classes, riders with two horses may have another junior hack and that junior need not be eligible by age. Horses entered in the Junior Working Hunter Division may not cross enter Section A & B of the Small Junior Hunters or Section A or B of the Large Junior Hunters.
